Most Homelessness Is Invisible and Goes Far Beyond Sleeping Rough



Hidden Homelessness

Almost 94% of the over 122,000 Australians facing homelessness are classed as secondary or tertiary homeless.

This includes:

- Couch surfing
- Emergency and temporary accomodation
- Living in accomodation that falls below minimum community standards.

Visible Homelessness

Only about **6%** of people who are homeless are sleeping rough.

...Putting Us In A Position To End Cycles Of Homelessness

MOBILISE MATCHED



An Australian-first direct cash transfer program. By integrating employment opportunities, ongoing support of housing and financial counselling, as well as substantial funding of up to \$10,000, Mobilise Matched provides a strong foundation for people to build their next chapter.

MOBILISE KICKSTARTER



Kickstarter empowers people to enter the property market or maintain their existing housing. This provides the stability and security of a home by covering their bond and rent for eight weeks: a stepping stone towards long-term stability and independence.

MOBILISE PAY



A direct giving program aimed at supporting single-mother families to pay their bills. This year-long program goes beyond financial assistance, utilising a voucher and gift system to cover necessities like utilities, groceries, and extracurricular activities for children.

By providing our participants with trust & autonomy, we empower them to use our platform and resources to write their own next chapter.



What Sets Us Apart?




Our approach is **tech-first**: finding ways to embed the latest tech to ensure we stay lean and scalable.





Corporate Pledges

According to a survey commissioned by New York-based Zeno Group of 8,000 global consumers and 75 companies, consumers are four to six times more likely to purchase, protect and champion purposedriven companies.

Contributing to a program like **Mobilise Kickstarter** is good for society and your business.



Secure regular recurring funding through philanthropy to scale the successful direct giving programs providing impact at scale




